Thank you again for making College Royal part of your own tradition, help us now by hitting this year's Open House out of the park!

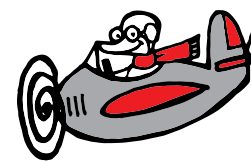

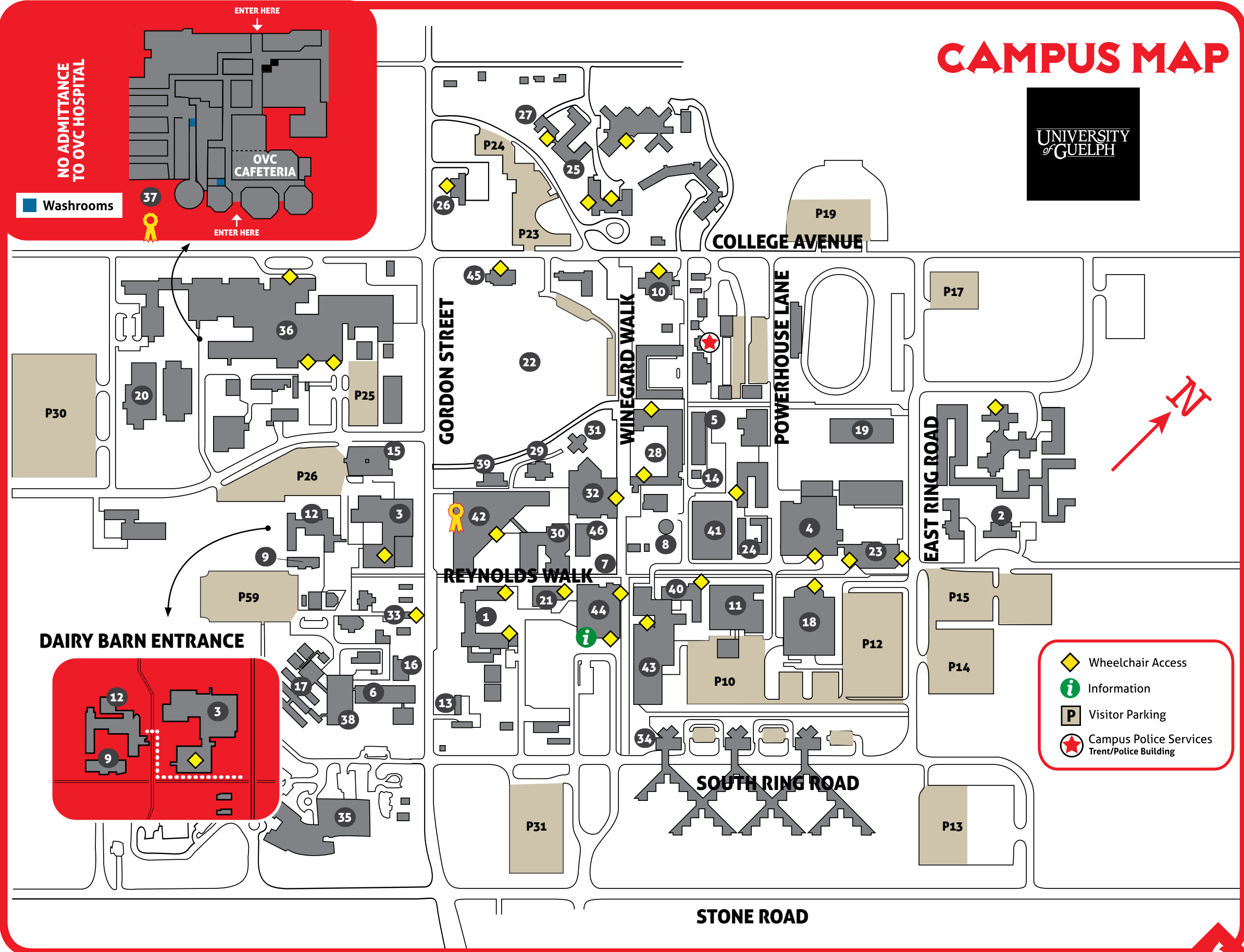
OVC INSET MAP



DAIRY BARN ENTRANCE

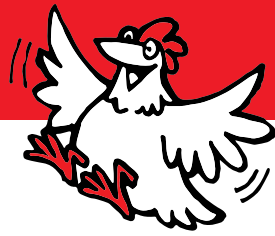


CAMPUS MAP

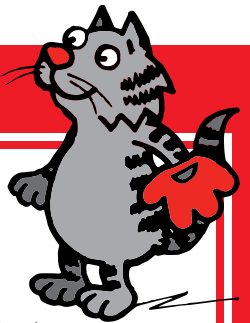

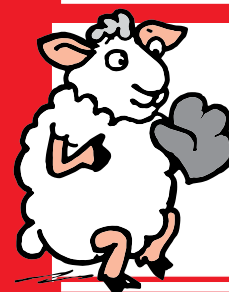

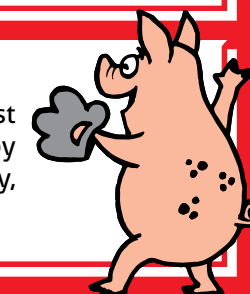
