WHAT TO EXPECT

Heeling

The principal feature of this exercise is the ability of the dog and the handler to work as a team. Ideally, the dog's shoulder should be in line with the handler's left leg. Different speeds, directions, and distractions will be utilized to challenge the dog. Depending on class level, this will take place on-or off-leash.



Sit and down stays

As a group, dogs must either sit or lay down for a required amount of time (depending on class level). Handlers will leave their dogs, wait the allotted amount of time, and then return to their dog. Dogs are not to disturb other dogs or leave position until handlers are back on their right side.



Sit and stand for exam

Handlers are asked to get their dogs into a sitting or standing position. The judge then approaches the dog and touches his/her back to demonstrate an ability to greet strangers without jumping all over them.



Recall

Dogs begin in a heeling position on the left, are asked to sit, then handlers leave their dog and walk to the other side of the ring, or a marked point. On cue, handlers will call their dogs, who should come and sit in front of them.



Tricks

The part of the show that everyone looks forward to the most!

Dogs will perform tricks to showcase their various skills. Tricks should relate to the dog's class level.



Grand Champion Selection

Takes place after all classes have concluded (4:00pm) and will include the winners of each class.
